PUTTING YOUR HARLEY-DAVIDSON INTO TRANSPORT MODE

Introduction

Your Harley-Davidson is fitted with a very good security alarm, but there are times when you don't want the alarm to be triggered.

Reasons could include:

- *You are moving your bike on a trailer
- *Your bike is on a ferry
- *Your bike is on a train
- *You are working on your bike

This guide sets out the easy steps how to put your bike in what Harley-Davidson call transport mode, which stops the alarm sounding.

Putting your motorcycle into Transport Mode keeps the system armed, but turns off the motion detector, so the alarm does not sound if the motorcycle is moved.

To put the bike into transport mode is very easy, but it depends on what model and age your motorcycle is.

A. If you have an older touring model with a button key fob (that you press to set the alarm)....

1. Turn the main Ignition switch to ON.
2. Press and hold key fob button until confirmation is received (turn signals flash 3 times).
3. Turn the main Ignition switch to OFF.
4. Press and hold key fob button until confirmation is received (turn signals flash 3 times).
5. The motorcycle can now be moved without triggering the alarm.
6. To reset the security system so the alarm sounds if the bike is moved, turn the main Ignition switch back to the IGNITION position.

B. If you have an newer touring model with a proximity key fob (but also see part C)....

1. With the assigned key fob in range, turn the main ignition switch to IGNITION.
2. On the right hand switchgear, turn the RUN/OFF button to the OFF position.
3. Turn the main ignition switch to ACCESSORIES (or ACC on some models).
4. Within three seconds, simultaneously press both the left and right turn signal switches once.
5. Turn the main ignition switch to OFF.
After the turn signals flash once, the system has entered transport mode. With the fob removed, the motorcycle can now be moved without triggering the alarm.
6. To reset the security system so the alarm sounds if the bike is moved, with the key fob present, turn the main Ignition switch back to the IGNITION position.

C. If you have a 2014, 2015 or 2016 Rushmore model of bike..... Or later model bike....

1. With the assigned key fob in range, turn the main ignition switch to IGNITION.
2. On the right hand switchgear, turn the RUN/OFF button to the ON position.
3. Before the security system lamp goes out, turn the main ignition switch to OFF
4. Within three seconds, simultaneously press both the left and right turn signal switches once.
5. After the turn signals flash once, the system has entered transport mode. With the fob removed, the motorcycle can now be moved without triggering the alarm.
6. To reset the security system so the alarm sounds if the bike is moved, with the key fob present, turn the main Ignition switch back to the IGNITION position.
